Notice to the students residing in the SAU hostel


Students residing in Akbar Bhawan are apprised that Delhi is in throes of a very serious health crisis due to the pandemic. The health infrastructure is unable to take load the numbers of patients, furthering the alarming condition in the capital. The media reports, press statements from the state governments and hospitals have pointed to acute crisis of oxygen, medicines and hospital beds. We have experienced the same in the context of a few students of our university. The SAU Hostel is a closed building with common facilities and the risk of infection transmission is very high. The University is especially concerned about the wellbeing of the students being caught in this alarming situation.

This notification is to announce to ALL students currently residing in Akbar Bhawan that for their own personal safety, must VACATE their hostel rooms and premises and DEPART for their respective homes and places of residence at the earliest possible opportunity and certainly **BEFORE 10 May, 2021**.

Because of the severe wave of COVID, the hostel administration is compelled to issue the advisory for vacating the hostel. We can tide over this unprecedented situation only with the cooperation from the student community.

Students are also advised to adhere to the **Corona protocol** to prevent themselves and others from getting infected.
